### **UNITED WAY READERS**

Volunteers provide one-on-one help to a child who's behind in learning how to read. United Way Readers work at the child's school in East Hartford, Enfield, Hartford, New Britain or Windham once a week for an hour to improve reading comprehension and vocabulary skills. Training is provided.

**School year sessions:** November– May. Volunteers must be able to commit to one, hour-long session per week.

### **VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE (VITA)**

IRS-certified volunteers prepare and file taxes for lower-to moderate-income families and individuals at no cost, getting them the refunds and credits they've earned. They also connect filers to other tools that help them on their paths to financial security. Training is required and provided.

**Mid-January through mid-April.** Volunteers must be able to commit to one, four-hour shift per week.
