Financial struggles affect families' health and children's education. Women United members empower each other to use our passions, ideas, expertise and resources to help women and families in our community achieve financial security.

#### **OUR IMPACT**

Women United raises awareness and funds to help ensure that women and families in our community are more financially secure. More than \$1.5 million has been raised though the organization's signature fundraising event – Power of the Purse Luncheon and Silent Auction - since 2012. Funds help ensure that participants in United Waysupported programs work to identify financial goals, develop realistic budgets, reduce debt, build savings, increase income and receive career coaching. In 2019 over 700 individuals enrolled in job training programs geared toward improving their employment potential and nearly 1,400 people participated in financial management programs to create a budget, save money, and reduce debt.\*
