

Since 2023, three organizations - Read to Grow, Reach Out and Read, and United Way of Central and Northeastern Connecticut / Dolly Parton Imagination Library - have joined together to pursue a vision that all of Connecticut's children will have access to books in their homes. With support from the State of Connecticut, we are making progress! Together with nearly 1,000 partners - including hospitals, clinics, nonprofit organizations and childcare providers - we have served nearly 90,000 young children. By providing books and learning resources, we are helping children from birth to age five to gain skills they will need in kindergarten. With continued support from the State of Connecticut, we can continue to ensure that young children have a strong foundation for lifelong learning.



- Books for Babies reaches 25,000 of the 35,000 babies born annually in Connecticut, giving board books and literacy packets to every baby born in 19 birthing hospitals statewide
- Books for Kids and Bookmobile distributed 101,198 books in more than five languages since July 2023
- 300+ community partners in hospitals, clinics, childcare providers, agencies and other nonprofits

EARLY LITERACY IMPACT



- 101 Clinic site locations, partnering with 594 pediatricians and clinicians
- Serving 60,717 children
- Distributed 111,633 books

- 4,674 children served in the program
- 78,492 books distributed to families
- Nationally, Dolly Parton's Imagination Library participants show evidence of improved skills directly related to kindergarten readiness, namely letter identification, phonologic awareness and letter naming fluency.
