Health and Wellness Care Package

Literacy Care Package (Grades K-3)

Care package includes: Book, Pencils, Crayons, Notebook, Craft or Activity (created by volunteers), Bookmark, Read Aloud Tip Sheet, Community Resources

\$15 per Care Package | Volunteers typically assemble 2 care packages each in one hour



Newborn-Toddler Care Package

Care package includes: Diapers, Onesies, Board Book, Bib, Socks, Wipes, Bookmark, Materials for Caregiver, Community Resources

\$15 per Care Package | Volunteers typically assemble 5-6 care packages each in one hour



Job Search-Interview Success Care Package

Care package includes: Notebook, Pen, Folder, Mints, Tips for Interview, Workforce Resources (job training, interview resources, upcoming events, etc.), CTtransit bus pass
